The 12th Annual Wentworth Charities Golf Classic Raises \$12,600 for Freedom Riders

Rockport, ME – The 12th Annual Wentworth Charities Golf Classic Tournament, an annual event of Ocean Properties, Ltd., has donated nearly \$950,000 to charities since its inception in 1995. Trained and experienced staff combine the expertise of instructors certified by North American Riding for the Handicapped (NARHA), and a specialist in developmental disabilities. All aspects of the program are overseen by a program coordinator and governed by a board of directors, comprised of professionals, parents, volunteers and other concerned citizens.
